A Brief about Mexico :

Mexico, country of southern North America and the third largest country in Latin America, after Brazil and Argentina. It is bordered to the north by the United States; to the south and west by the Pacific Ocean; to the southeast by Guatemala, Belize, and the Caribbean Sea; and to the east by the Gulf of Mexico. Given Mexico's geographic position, it has been an intersection that has allowed the encounter of people and of cultures from all over the world, a developing nation with a vibrant culture, which incorporates the elements of several different traditions. It is a large country rich in natural resources that presents a variety of spectacular landscapes, notable tropical beaches, humid forests, mountains with snowy summits, fertile earth and tempered forests as well as vast deserts.

Mexican society is characterized by extremes of wealth and poverty, with a limited middle class wedged between an elite cadre of landowners and investors on the one hand and masses of rural and urban poor on the other. But in spite of the challenges it faces as a developing country, Mexico is one of the chief economic and political forces in Latin America. It has a dynamic industrial base, vast mineral resources, a wide-ranging service sector, and the world's largest population of Spanish speakers—about two and a half

times that of Spain or Colombia. As its official name suggests, the Estados Unidos Mexicanos (United Mexican States) incorporates 31 socially and physically diverse states and the Federal District.

As a newly industrialized and developing country ranking 86th in the Human Development Index, its large economy and population, cultural influence, and steady democratization make of Mexico a regional and middle power which is also identified as an emerging power by several analysts. Mexico ranks first in the Americas and seventh in the world for the number of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. It is also one of the world's 17 megadiverse countries, ranking fifth in natural biodiversity. Mexico's rich cultural and biological heritage, as well as varied climate and geography, makes it a major tourist destination: as of 2018, it was the sixth most-visited country in the world, with 39 million international arrivals. However, the country continues to struggle with social inequality, poverty and extensive crime. Mexico's economic and social elements are equally dynamic; within the country, industries and towns exist alongside rural villages and agricultural farms. Today, Mexico is a land combining ancient customs with the challenges of a changing environment. As Mexicans preserve their culture whilst they also modernize the country.

GEOGRAPHY :

Mexico is located between latitudes 14° and 33°N, and longitudes 86° and 119°W in the southern portion of North America. Almost all of Mexico lies in the North American Plate, with small parts of the Baja California peninsula on the Pacific and Cocos Plates. Geophysically, some geographers include the territory east of the Isthmus of Tehuantepec (around 12% of the total) within Central America.^[125] Geopolitically, however, Mexico is entirely considered part of North America, along with Canada and the United States. Mexico's total area is 1,972,550 km² (761,606 sq mi), making it the world's 13th largest country by total area. Sharing a common border throughout its northern extent with the United States, Mexico is bounded to the west and south by the Pacific Ocean, to the east by the Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean Sea, and to the southeast by Guatemala and Belize. Mexico is located in one of the Earth's most dynamic tectonic areas. It is a part of the circum-Pacific "**Ring of Fire**"—a region of active volcanism and frequent seismic activity. Mexico is situated on the western, or leading, edge of the huge North American Plate, whose interaction with the Pacific, Cocos, and Caribbean plates has given rise to numerous and severe earthquakes as well as the earth-building processes that produce southern Mexico's rugged landscape. It is in this dynamic and often unstable physical environment that the Mexican people have built their country. The climate varies from tropical to desert, the terrain ranges from high rugged mountains to low coastal plains and high plateaus to desert. Mexican natural hazards include tsunamis on the Pacific coast, volcanoes and destructive earthquakes at the center and south, and hurricanes on the Gulf of Mexico and Caribbean coasts.

ECONOMY :

Mexico is rich in natural resources, like oil, silver, copper, and agricultural products. Its economy boasts a rich diversity of agricultural crops, highly productive oil fields, a growing manufacturing base, as well as strong trade with the United States and Canada.

Mexico has a developing market economy that is strongly tied to that of the United States, with its major markets and sources of capital. The Mexican economy is one of the more influential in Latin America and has grown rapidly since the 1970s. It has the world's 15th-largest economy by nominal GDP and the 11th-largest by PPP, with the United States being its largest economic partner. However, the country's per capita gross domestic product (GDP) remains far below that of the United States. The Mexican economy depends largely on services—including trade, transportation, finance, and government—which account for about two-thirds of GDP. Manufacturing is responsible for about one-fifth of GDP. Although nearly one-fifth of Mexican workers are employed in the agricultural sector, it accounts for only a tiny part of GDP. On the other hand, remittances from Mexican workers abroad, notably in the United States, bring billions of dollars into the economy each year. It has become the United States' second-largest export market and third-

largest source of imports. In 2017, two-way trade in goods and services exceeded \$623 billion. Mexico has free trade agreements with 46 countries, putting more than 90% of its trade under free trade agreements. In 2012, Mexico formed the Pacific Alliance with Peru, Colombia, and Chile. For much of the 20th century, Mexico's economy was largely characterized by state-owned and mixed-capital enterprises combined with a highly regulated private sector. The government strictly controlled foreign investment and imports and barred private investors from ownership in many activities, including mining, forestry, insurance, and power production.

Political Scenerio :

Mexico City is the seat of the federal government, and local and national politics intertwine there like nowhere else in Mexico. The city's residents have long had a powerful voice in politics, owing to their large and dense population (and their correspondingly large number of registered voters) and their ability to launch massive protests in the city streets. In addition, *chilangos* elect a proportion of deputies (representatives) and senators to the national Congress. In accordance with its Political Constitution, Mexico is a representative, democratic and federal republic governed by three branches of power: the executive, the legislative and the judiciary. The country is made up of 32 political-administrative entities (31 free, sovereign states, and the Federal District, the seat of the Executive, which is also where the nation's capital is located).

Mexico's government is composed of the **Legislative, Executive and Judicial Branches**. Members of the legislative Branch and the head of the Executive Branch are elected by the citizens' direct vote. The first two designate members of the Judicial Branch. There are two levels of Government: Federal and Local, both subordinate to the Constitution. At the local level, the Municipality is the form of political and administrative organization that is closest to the people.

Scattered throughout the city are headquarters and offices for all of the federal executive, legislative, and judicial branches of government. The president's official seat of power is the National Palace, originally the residence of the viceroys during the colonial period. It is located on the east side of the Zócalo, where enormous crowds gather every September 15 at 11 PM (on the eve of Mexican Independence Day) to join the president in the 200-year-old battle cry known as the Grito de Dolores (Cry of Dolores).

For much of Mexico City's history, its residents did not elect local leaders. The president appointed a trusted party member to serve as its chief of government (*jefe del gobierno*), or mayor, who then became one of the most powerful politicians in the country.

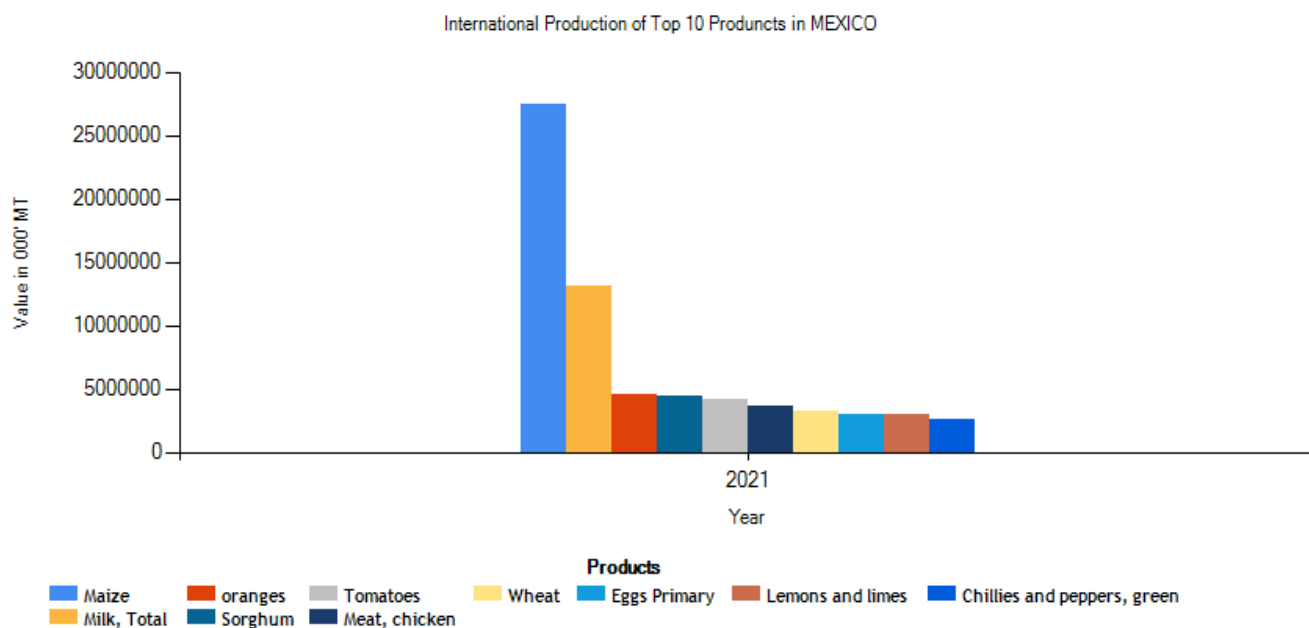
The city's government, which is headquartered along the south side of the Zócalo, is structured much like the national government. The executive branch includes key secretariats, or ministries, such as a state secretariat and another that oversees public works and services. Other ministries deal with public safety, finance, environment, transportation and circulation, human welfare, and justice. The mayor once appointed trusted followers to head each of the *delegaciones*, but since 2000 they have been directly elected. In addition, the Federal District has a legislative assembly, similar to those of the Mexican states. Its members are elected to three-year terms.

Port Facilities in Mexico:

1. Port of Manzanillo

Location : It is situated in the State of Colima on the western Pacific Coast of Mexico and has direct shipping connections with 125 ports in more than 40 countries including the United States, Canada, Japan, India, China, Russia and Germany.

Export Items : Principal exports comprise fish, corn, lemons, bananas, canned food, wine, copra, lumber, cement, etc. Repackaging services for shoes, clothes and chemical products are also provided.

Capacity : In 2021, the port handled 3.37 million TEUs, a 15.9 % increase from the previous year, making it the busiest container facility in Mexico.

Additional features : The port covers 437 hectares of land area and consists of 19 operational berths divided among a breakbulk terminal, an international container terminal, an oil terminal and a passenger terminal capable of accommodating the biggest cruise ships.

2. Port of Lazaro Cardenas

A well-protected, deepwater port lying at the mouth of the river Rio Balsas on Mexico's Pacific coastline in the State of Michoacán.

It is the second busiest in the country with an annual capacity of 25 million tonnes of cargo and 2,250,000 TEUs. It is the only Mexican port with an 18 m wide access channel capable of receiving the largest cargo vessels.

In 2021, 1.69 million TEUs were handled at its container terminal, recording a tremendous 58.9% growth from 2020.

Major exports include iron plate, steel bars, diammonium, phosphate and container goods.

3. Port of Ensenada

Located near Todos Santos Bay off the Pacific Ocean in the State of Baja California Due to its advantageous position near the US border and the Pacific Rim, it has access to crucial international shipping routes, linking it with 64 ports in 29 countries.

It covers 9000 square miles and contains 6 multipurpose wharves for handling all types of cargo

Olives and grapes are produced in abundance while the majority of cotton is exported to Asian countries and the United States. Other export products include limestone, crushed rock, bagged stones and sand. Fertiliser is the main import arriving from Asia, Nicaragua and New Zealand.

The port has handled around 394,911 TEUs in 2021.

4.Port of Mazatlan

Situated in the State of Sinaloa in western Mexico, it is the fourth biggest container port in the country which handled 41,895 TEUs in 2021.

A popular resort town on the Pacific Coast, it is known for its golden sand beaches and picturesque waterfront overlooking the international cruise terminal. It possesses the second-biggest commercial fishing fleet in Mexico and boasts a thriving fishing industry.

economy rests on agro-based industries like food processing, fish meal and brewing, however, industrial cargoes such as rolled steel, containers and automobiles are also received at the port.

5.Port of Veracruz

The Port of Veracruz is located on the Gulf Coast of Mexico near the Bay of Campeche. It serves the central and southern regions of the country and is also connected to North and South America, Europe and Africa.

Approximately 1,600 vessels, 16,50,000 tonnes of cargo and 560,000 TEUs are handled annually at this facility.

The port is handling diverse cargo such as corn, petroleum coke, wheat, soya, containers, steel, metal scrap, vegetable oil, rice, tallow, benzene, canola, pig iron, clinker, automobiles, machinery, chemicals etc. It is also an important fishing port and also provides water sports facilities. People from all over the world flock to the city to enjoy the Carnaval, an annual festival featuring colourful parades, local food, dance and music.

6.Port of Guaymas

Situated near the Gulf of California off the Pacific Ocean in the State of Sonora, Positioned at the mouth of the Rio Yaqui, the port is an important shipping, industrial and tourism centre of Mexico.

Around 6.6 million tonnes of cargo and over 1000 ships passed through the Guaymas port in 2020. It boasts one of the best natural harbours in the world

It serves the agricultural hinterland and exports cash crops like cotton, vegetables, wheat, corn, soy, livestock, furniture, and metals like copper, magnetite, and gypsum.

7.Port of Tampico

Tampico Port lies on the northern bank of the Río Pánuco in the State of Tamaulipa and is the major maritime gateway for petrochemical and mining products, steel, wood, metals, minerals, molasses and other industrial products.

Approximately 8,831,000 tonnes of cargo including 11,000 TEUs are handled at the facility annually.

8.Port of Altamira

Port lies on the Gulf of Mexico and serves the economic and industrial regions of the country including the state of Tamaulipas, Coahuila, San Luis Potosi, etc

It handles petroleum, LNG, agave fibre, sugar, cattle, copper, coffee, hides and containerised cargo. Around 1550 ships, 12,185,000 tonnes of cargo and 397,000 TEUs are handled at the port every year

9.Port of Coatzacoalcos

This port lies at the mouth of the Coatzacoalcos River and is the main oil port of the nation having a natural harbour divided into two portions; a free port lying on the western bank of the river and the Pajaritos oil port owned by Pemex company.

It primarily exports petroleum products manufactured in Minatitlán followed by forest products, agricultural goods and consumer goods.

It has 8 conventional berths, and 9 tanker berths and handles 1,350 vessels carrying 29,220,000 tonnes of cargo annually.

10.Port of Topolobampo

Located on the western coast of Mexico in a highly fertile agricultural zone that produces more than half of the country's agricultural output.

Hence, crops like wheat, soy, sorghum, vegetables, and fruits comprise the majority of exports followed by livestock.

Approximately 1000 ships, 4,850,000 tonnes of cargo and 185,000 passengers are handled at this port annually. It is connected to northern Mexico through the Chihuahua Pacific railroad and has trading partners across the globe, such as Japan, Singapore, Korea, New Zealand, Taiwan and the Americas.
